Finally, from the back in the corner, a third volunteer stepped forward and said, "I will tell them there is a heaven and there is a hell, but there is plenty of time for everything!"

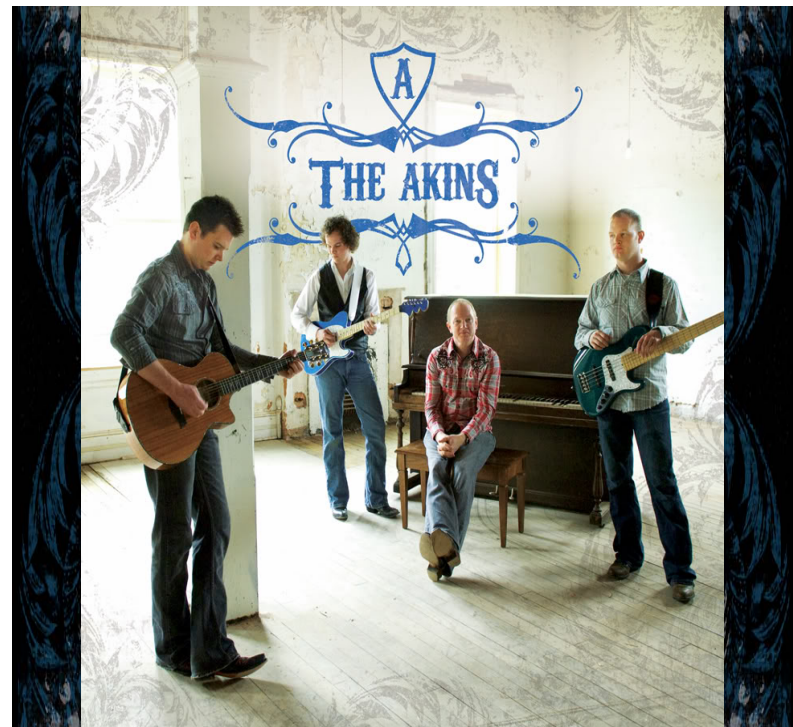
The devil smiled and said, "That will work indeed. You can go forth as my servant."

Such is so often our own curse! We crucify ourselves between the sky of our intentions and the ground of our actions. "To be or not to be" is what Shakespeare did say, but "To do or not to do" is the question for today. The Bible values the virtue of "doing" the right things—not simply possessing good thoughts. 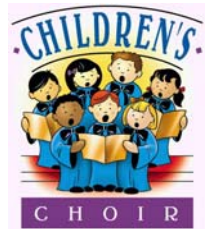

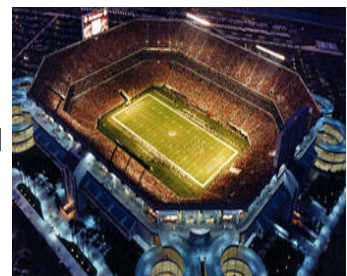
